



ELTI level of representativeness


EU LEAF TOBACCO CONTRACTED VOLUMES (TONS) CROP 2017

ELTI main figures

- 11 tobacco producing countries
- 76,000 hectares of tobacco cultivated land
- **▶ 150,000** tobacco tons delivered
- **500**M€ tobacco farmers revenue (commercial price paid)
- ◆ 12 National growers' Associations
- 46 Producers Organisations/Cooperatives
- **51,000** individual growers/farms
- 4 first processors' National Associations
- 18 first processing Companies
- 350,000 workers (50% women) + tens of thousands in associated jobs

ELTI recognition process

- Feb 16, 2016: EU COM Delegated Reg. 232/2016 entered into force
- May 20, 2016: UNITAB and FETRATAB agreed to set-up an EU level transnational IBO in the raw tobacco sector
- Oct 4, 2016: ELTI public notary establishment and presentation at UNITAB Congress in Sofia, immediately started the discussion on the recognition process with the Italian MoA (Mipaaf)
- May 22, 2017: Official ELTI presentation, Assembly and Congress held at Mipaaf, more than 100 EU attending stakeholders / delegates
- Feb 6, 2018: official request of cooperation by Mipaaf to all other EU producing MS MoAs for the green light on ELTI recognition
- Aug 3, 2018: transnational EU IBO Official recognition decree

ELTI main goals

- Strengthen the aggregation and the contractual power of EU tobacco growers to achieve farming economic sustainability
- Officially represent the EU leaf tobacco sector common issues at EU Institutions to re-gain dignity for the tobacco growers among all EU farmers, fighting discrimination in the CAP
- Define EU umbrella harmonized rules for the proper functioning and control of the leaf tobacco market, tackling the illicit
- Achieve the world best quality standards in terms of leaf tobacco integrity, overall quality, Good Agriculture and Labour Practices
- Provide economic sustainability and perspectives to EU leaf tobacco, boosting manufacturers' multiannual purchase programs and commitments
- Support the activities of national IBOs or growers' and processors' Associations in MS without national IBOs, in a coordinated way and increase position and level of representativeness
