1. Producer Organisations (POs) Main provisions in Regulation (EC) 1308/2013 (from Art. 152):

- Member States may recognize POs in tobacco sector
- * to pursue specific aims (in Art. 152, 11 aims defined)
- be a legal entity or clearly defined part of a legal entity and with statutes
- have a min. number of members and/or cover a min. volume or value of marketable production
- Recognition procedure
- extension of rules





2. Creation Producer Organisations (POs)

Possible EU financing

see Regulation (EC) 1305/2013 Rural Development (Art. 27)

- ☐ to facilitate creations
- ☐ for officially recognised POS by a MS
- need to follow some determined purposes
- ☐ business plan objectives to be reached within 5 years
- ☐ financial support as a flat rate in annual instalments
- ☐ max. Euros 100.000





3. Interbranch Organisations (IOs) Main additional provisions - Reg. (EC) 1308/2013 (from Art. 157):

- Member States shall recognize IOs in tobacco sector
- possib. to pursue additional aims (in Art. 162)
 - a) concentrating/ coordinating supply and marketing
 - b) adapting production and processing
 - c) promoting the rationalisation and improvement of production
- * provisions for recognition (see Com. Reg. (EC) 709/2008).
- extension of rules
- financial contribution of non-members
- Notification and publication on the EU Official Journal C.
